Finding Units

Unit Finder

The Unit Finder map shows scouting units closest to the address you enter. The map is not restricted to any particular Council or District. Select URL <http://www.sfbac.org/unitfinder/>

1. Type in your address information.
2. Select the Scouting Program Type.
3. Select Meeting days.
4. Select either Display Map and List or Display List Only.
5. Select Number of units to show. Select 5 first.
6. The map area will expand or collapse as you select more or less units.
7. Click on Submit.
 - ✓ Map is displayed with Scouting icons and their approximate location.
 - ✓ Click on hyperlinks below the map for unit specific data.
 - ✓ Print hardcopy (if desired) for reference.
